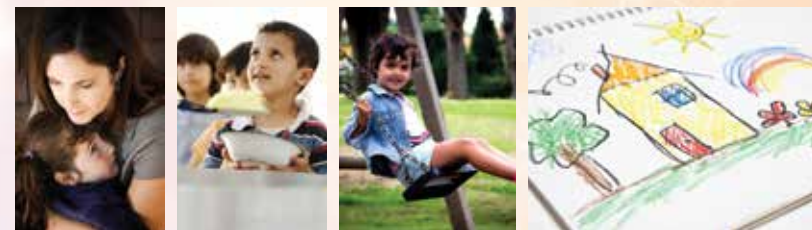

A Bright, Shining Future

In the United States, an estimated 1.6 million children are homeless. According to studies by the NMECC, over 18,000 children experienced homelessness in New Mexico last year; at least 8,000 of these were children under the age of 6.

The traumatic and potentially dangerous experience of homelessness negatively impacts children's overall development, health, and ability to succeed in school. Homelessness not only breaks up families, but has negative consequences for our community as well. Childhood homelessness significantly increases risk for severe depression, substance abuse, teenage pregnancy, dropping out of school, poverty, domestic violence, and criminal involvement.

Sadly, over one-third of the homeless population at **A Path Home** consists of homeless families with children.

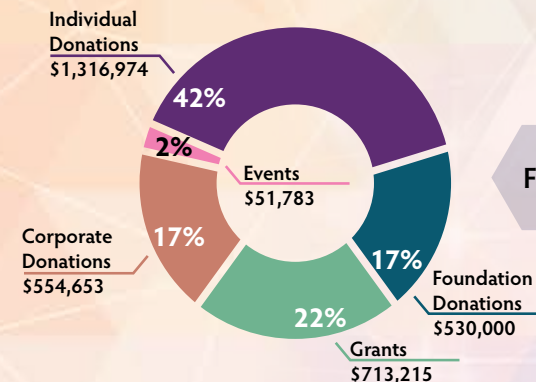
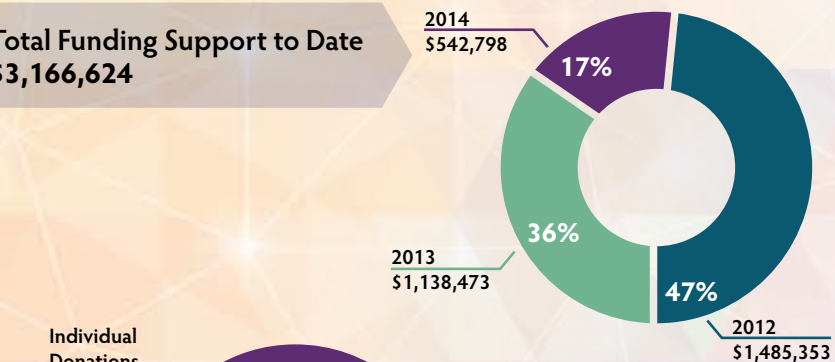


Sharing the Light Financial Summary

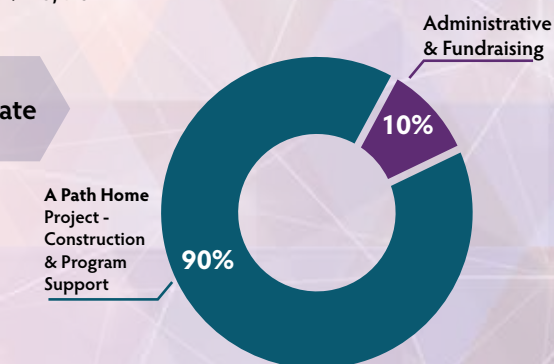
The Foundation's Financial Committee oversees the Foundation's financial accounting process, system of internal controls and auditing process.

Shining the Light on A Path Home

A monumental project by any standard, **A Path Home**, reflects our community's deep commitment to care for people in need. Construction of the \$3.5 million dollar emergency and transitional housing development was completed in June 2014. The new, substance-free facility is twice the size of the old shelter which means twice as many homeless individuals and families with children are receiving help with basic human needs; shelter, food, and clothing. Residents are also directed to other local support services to receive the help they need on their journey to independence.

Awareness and education about the impact of local homelessness shed a new light on the issue and changed the community conversation about homelessness. Therefore, A Path Home is leased at no charge to PATH (People Assisting the Homeless), a yearly value of \$163,000. Our gift expands the capacity for effective emergency and transitional-living programs which teach more homeless individuals and families how to effectively break the cycle of homelessness for good!
